From the last newsletter we have achieved Gold in our Investor In People accreditation. The IIP report was **really impressive** and a copy can be found on our web site.

One of the recommendations from the assessment was for us to review the current reward and recognition

Care Inspectorate:

Our recent unannounced Care Inspectorate visit in May brought us another fantastic achievement. We were assessed against the new National Care Standards and we were awarded for a 6 for Quality of Care and Support and Quality of leadership and management. Here are three quotes from the report:

They have been delivering the feedback from service users to Fair Deal and coming up with ideas and solutions. They also helped Fair Deal with a new service user evaluation process.

After the summer they will be meeting service users to gather their views about their service, be meeting with community police and their local MP Stewart McDonald to tell them about issues in their communities for people with learning disability and if they have any ideas or solutions.
